## KNITTING

### Beginner Knitting

Join the ranks of the knitters! This course is for people who have a minimal knitting knowledge or no previous knowledge of knitting. You will learn to cast on stitches, knit stitch, purl stitch, casting off, counting rows, measuring work, 3 needle cast off, increasing, decreasing, stitch recognition in simple pattern; basket, ribbing and seed stitch, reading and understanding patterns. At the end of the course you will be able to make a simple garment from a pattern.

## Free Motion Machine Embroidery

This class introduces the student to free motion embroidery. In this class the student will learn how to prepare their sewing machine and fabric for free motion machine embroidery. They will learn about supplies (thread, tension, stabilizers, needles, etc.), and stitches (straight and zig zag) and techniques (open work, solid work, shading, couching, texture, etc.) and much more. Many samples shown during the class and detailed notes provided.

This technique is the ultimate "clean up" technique. It uses up all your scraps and leaves virtually nothing behind. The resulting serendipitous fabric can be an eye catching bright chaos of colour or a subtle background for other work.

## Creative Ways of Using Cheese Cloth



Learn several interesting ways to use Cheese Cloth in your fibre art work. Applique - learn the different ways to do applique with cheese cloth to get different effects from see-through fins to skeletonized leaves and shaded areas in landscapes. Molded 3-D Cheese Cloth - Turn cheese cloth into permanent 3-D art pieces. Foundation for needle felting - Add the warm and texture of rovings to the drape of cheese cloth to create an awesome new fabric. Needle felted cheese cloth for surface texture. Surface Texture - use cheese cloth to add texture to surfaces such as the skin of a cantaloupe or the bark of a tree. Lace – Use cheese cloth to create lace.

## QUILTING

### Beginner Quilting

During this class the students will learn 12 different techniques of machine quilting: outline, stitch-in-the-ditch, channel, cross-hatching machine guided curves and points, free motion curves and points, continuous line, meandering, stipple,

echo, trapunto, tying.

Also, the student will learn how to join these quilted blocks together in a unique way that allows you to quilt the quilt, block by block instead of wrestling with the whole quilt under the sewing machine. Students will work with our Husqvarna Viking sewing machines.

### Serger Techniques



This is a hands on class that uses our in store Husqvarna sergers. This course will teach you how to thread and set your machine to achieve proper tension using not only regular threads but also rayons, metallics, and Woolly Nylon, as well as a variety of fabrics including fleece, spandex and cotton. You will learn to navigate corners and to do such specialty techniques as flat lock, rolled hems, cover stitch, gathers, and beading. You will even create sculptured ruffles using sheer fabrics and fishing wire! This is an information packed course for both the novice and experienced sewer. Making a T-shirt that fits is a simple matter! It can be fashionable in varying styles and fabrics. Learn the techniques to create your T-shirt with a traditional, turtleneck, v-neck or scoop neck. Sleeves can be short, long, or anywhere in between. In this introductory stretch sewing course, you will use a Husqvarna Viking serger and fashion fabrics to create your own versatile, stylish T-shirt. Students will require items on supply list. We supply the sergers.
